1. The Inter-College Tournaments of various games will be organized every academic session as per calendar approved by Sports Council.
2. The venue and dates will be finalized in the sports council meeting. However, minor changes in the dates will be allowed to the organizers under exceptional circumstances in consultation with Director of Sports, GJUS&T, Hisar
3. The Draws/ Fixtures of Inter-College Tournaments will be finalized by the Directorate of Sports, GJUS&T Hisar in the presence of representatives of affiliated colleges/UTD, if present.
4. The Host college will charge officiating fees @ Rs. 250/- per team per match and will make the payment to the officials/ referee/ umpires/ Ballboys as per university rule along with TA/DA if applicable.
5. In case of any protest, a protest fees of Rs 500/- per protest will have to be deposited to the organizing secretary of Inter-College Tournament and the decision will be made by the Jury of Appeal comprising of Principal/Director of Sports, Organizing Secretary and Observer of the University appointed by the Director of Sports, GJUS&T, Hisar. The TA/DA of the observer will be borne by the University.
7. Selection procedure of University Teams for Inter- university Tournaments: a) The selection committee will comprise of the following: 1. Principal/ Director of the Host college/ Director Sports UTD 2. Organizing Secretary of the tournament/ Incharge sports of Host college 3. Observer of the University/ nominee of Director of Sports, GJUS&T, Hisar.
4. Game Expertb) The trials for the selection of university teams will be held on the last day of Inter-College Tournaments in the host college/UTD. In case Inter-College Tournament is not
held than direct trials for selection of university teams can be conducted at UTD in the presence of selection committee constituted by Director of Sports, GJUS&T, Hisar. c) Trial fees @ Rs. 50/- per head will be charged from each college/UTD along with the list of Players by the host college. The Host college will have to deposit the trial fees to the Director Sports Fund, GJUS&T Hisar in the form of DD/ Cash receipt in favor of
