At the very outset Prof. Tankeshwar Kumar, Vice-Chancellor welcomed all the new members of the Executive Council Prof. Rajendrakumar Anayath, Prof. Pradeep Sharma Snehi, Prof. Pawan Kumar, Prof. Bhupinder Singh & Prof. J. B. Dahiya, nominated on the Executive Council and introduced them with other members and apprised the following to the house:-

- 1. The State Govt. has sanctioned teaching and non-teaching posts for the following new departments:
 - i) Department of Economics
 - ii) Department of Civil Engineering
 - iii) Department of Electrical Engineering
 - iv) Department of English
 - v) Department of Hindi

Three departments at Sr. No. i) to iii) have already been started from the academic session 2018-19. Two departments at Sr. No. iv) and v) will be started from the next academic session.

- 2. Department of Ministry of Human Resource Development has sanctioned Rs. 50.00 Crore under RUSA grant for research & innovation.
- 3. NBA accreditation of four Bachelor of Technology programmes has been conducted successfully under the Co-ordinatorship of Prof. Yogesh Chaba, Dean Faculty of Engineering & Technology.
- 4. The University Grants Commission has granted Graded Autonomy to this University as Category-II under Categorization of Universities, Regulations, 2018.

1. Confirmed the minutes of the 80th meeting held on 21.03.2018 (circulated vide letter no. Acad./AC-II/EC-80/2018/1469-1496 dated 25.04.2018).

2.

- i) Noted the follow-up action report on the decisions of the 79th meeting held on 03.02.2018 (Annexure-I Pages 3-22 of the agenda).
 - While noting the follow up action of Resolution No. 31 of 78th meeting held on 16.10.2017, it was further resolved that the Vice-Chancellor be authorized to expedite the matter as and when the need for shifting/allotment of house(s) on the nature of disability ground arises and the disabled employees be given preference.
 - II While noting the follow up action of Resolution No. 5, of 79th meeting of the Executive Council the recommendations of the Committee were placed before the Executive Council on the table and the Vice-Chancellor be authorized to constitute a fresh Committee to further reexamine the matter to make the draft amendments in the University Statutes for nominations of Non-teaching Employees on the Executive Council and Teachers & Principals of affiliated colleges on all Statutory bodies of the University i.e. the Court, Executive Council, Academic Council and Faculty etc. and submit its report before the Executive Council.
 - III While noting the follow up action of Resolution No. 25, of 79th meeting of the Executive Council it was also resolved that the appointment of other Officers of the University (Statutory position) be also placed before the Executive Council in future.
- **Noted** the follow-up action report on the decisions of the 80th meeting held on 21.03.2018 (Annexure-II Pages 23-34 of the agenda).
 - I While noting the follow up action of Resolution No. 8, it was also resolved that the request of the Chairperson for downgrading of the post be attached (Appendix 'A').
 - II While noting the follow up action of Resolution No. 26 (iii), it was resolved that the Vice-Chancellor who is the Chairperson of the House has regretted for not implementing the decision taken by the Executive Council, which was also not recorded in the minutes of 80th meeting of the Executive Council, for suspension and withdrawn of administrative powers of Prof. N. S. Malik, Haryana School of Business on the complaint by Mr. Sanjay Singh, TPO. Further, the Committee constituted in the manhandling issue by the Executive Council will continue its enquiry and submit its report before the next meeting of the Executive Council.

In view of the recent activities, and complaint received, it appears it is not possible that two Officers to stay in the same department. Therefore, to avoid conflict of interest, it was resolved that Sh. Sanjay Singh, TPO be transferred with post to Training and Placement Cell of the University. Director, Placement Cell shall coordinate with Director, Haryana School of Business.

3. Considered the request of Sh. Narender Kumar, Assistant Librarian for counting of past service rendered by him from 05.09.2005 to 24.07.2014 at Technological Institute of Textile & Sciences, Bhiwani for benefit under CAS (AGP of Rs.8000/- Stage-3) w.e.f. 01.09.2016 instead of benefit already granted (AGP of Rs.7000/- Stage-2) without counting his previous service w.e.f. 25.07.2014 i.e the date of joining in this university as he had already granted the AGP of Rs.7000/- in his previous institute w.e.f. 01.09.2011.

Resolved that the above proposal be re-examined in the light of letter dated 21.7.2011 of the Finance Department in this regard.
